

THE ST.CHRYSOSTOM’S DAY SCHOOL HEALTH & ATTENDANCE POLICY

The St. Chrysostom’s Day School is a well child facility.

All enrolled students must have on file the State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination dated after **July 1st, 2000.**

If a child comes to school and becomes ill or is not able to participate in the daily activities of school because of an illness, the parents will be called and the child will be cared for in the school office until the parents arrive to pick he/she up.

Our entire staff is certified in “ Recognizing and Caring for the Mildly Ill Child” in a non-clinical setting. Children who have a temperature should remain at home for a minimum of 24 hours after the temperature has returned to normal. Pre-school age children who have runny noses are highly contagious, as are children with diarrhea, pinkeye, strep throat, chicken pox, hand, foot & mouth disease, head lice and a host of other contagious diseases. Fatigue in young children is not normal and may indicate that a child is coming down with an illness.

If your child is going to be absent for illness, or any other reason, we need to be informed by telephone before school. If your child has a contagious disease we need to know so that we can notify our families and alert them to watch for particular symptoms. Your cooperation in keeping children who are not well at home will be greatly appreciated.

Working together we can insure that your child has a happy, healthy school year.
